I will be brief. Please produce the following immediately as they are material to my ongoing criminal referral and to the record in the eviction matter:

- 1. The complete text message from the owner stating that "Hanson has the check" or any equivalent message acknowledging receipt or possession of the payment.
- 2. Any USPS or Postmaster proof of delivery, signed receipt, or chain-of-custody documentation showing who accepted the cashier's/eCheck package delivered May 30, 2024 (or the actual delivery date).
- 3. Any correspondence or notes showing you or your client contacted the Post Office about this parcel and the outcome of that contact.
- 4. Any other documentary evidence your client intends to rely on that proves the payment was not received by Berkshire Hathaway or its agent.

I have already notified law enforcement and will request Postmaster verification. If the Post Office confirms interception, I will be referring the matter to the United States Postal Inspection Service and the FBI as appropriate. I am also sharing this evidence with the Huntington Beach PD.
