- BBB confirms he is a sole proprietor with no associates.
- This constitutes a **deliberate misrepresentation** in violation of:
 - California Rules of Professional Conduct (CRPC) 7.1–7.5
 - Business and Professions Code §17500
 - Rule 1-400 (false or misleading communications to the public)

I hired him believing I was retaining a staffed law firm.

2. Constructive Abandonment (Rule 1.16(d))

- Accepted \$8,000 retainer.
- Failed to upload key documents or contact opposing counsel.
- Refused to return my case file despite **five written requests**.
- Withdrew days before trial via a certified letter timed to arrive late.
- Did not help me secure alternative representation during a recess.

This violates:

- CRPC 1.3 (diligence)
- CRPC 1.4 (communication)
- CRPC 1.16(d) (duty upon termination of representation)

3. Mail Fraud (18 U.S.C. §1341) & Wire Fraud (18 U.S.C. §1343)

- Used USPS to mail a withdrawal letter under suspicious timing.
- Sent misleading communications over email.
- Marketed his services online as a "firm," inducing clients to pay under false pretense.

These acts amount to criminal fraud.

4. Elder Financial Abuse (Welfare & Institutions Code §15610.30)

- I am 72 years old, medically monitored (cardiac) during case.
- He ignored health disclosures and court pressure.
- Caused financial harm, emotional trauma, and medical deterioration.
- Ignored duty of care and heightened legal obligations owed to elders.

This rises to **criminal exploitation of a senior citizen**.

III. DAMAGES SUFFERED

- Wrongful eviction and housing loss
- Medical decline (stress-induced heart monitoring)
- Loss of studio and household stability
- Collapse of court case due to attorney sabotage
- Financial harm exceeding \$300,000

IV. DOCUMENTATION AVAILABLE

Certified mail records and USPS delivery timelines

- Screenshots of his false firm branding (BBB, Yelp, firm website)
- Email evidence showing requests for file and abandonment
- Medical records (Dr. Chesnie heart monitor documentation)
- Court documents proving absence and harm caused

V. REQUEST FOR ACTION

I formally request that the **State Bar of California**:

- 1. **Launch an investigation** into Mr. Rosiak's conduct.
- 2. **Pursue disbarment proceedings** based on evidence of repeated violations.
- 3. **Refer for criminal fraud charges** as appropriate.
- 4. Assist in recovering funds or refer for civil malpractice suit.

Mr. Rosiak has operated deceptively for years. He used **false credentials**, misrepresented his business, and left an elderly client defenseless in court. This is a betrayal not just of the legal profession, but of public trust.





I. RENT CAP AND JUST CAUSE ADDENDUM TERMS

With certain exemptions, Landlord may be subject to the rent cap and just cause eviction provisions of the Civil Code. Landlord informs Tenant of the following:

California law limits the amount your rent can be increased. See Section 1947.12 of the Civil Code for more information. California law also provides that after all of the Tenants have continuously and lawfully occupied the property for 12 months or more or at least one of the Tenants has continuously occupied the property for 24 months or more, a landlord must provide a statement of cause in any notice to terminate a tenancy. See Section 1946.2 of the Civil Code for more information.

II. EXEMPTIONS TO BOTH RENT CAP REQUIREMENTS AND JUST CAUSE EVICTIONS*:

- 1. Housing that has been issued a certificate of occupancy within the previous 15 years.
- A property containing two separate dwelling units (excluding ADUs and junior ADUs) within a single structure in which one of the units was Owner occupied at the commencement and throughout the tenancy.
- Single Family Residential property (including a condominium and units in planned developments) that is alienable separate from the title to any other dwelling unit if the notice below is checked and delivered to the Tenant:

Notice of Exemption: This property is not subject to the rent limits imposed by Section 1947.12 of the Civil Code				
and is not subject to the just cause requirements of Section 1946.2 of the Civil Code. This property meets the				
requirements of Sections 1947.12 (d)(5) and 1946.2 (e)(8) of the Civil Code AND the Owner is not any of the				
following: (1) a real estate investment trust, as defined by Section 856 of the Internal Revenue Code; (2) a				
corporation; or (3) a limited liability company in which at least one member is a corporation.				

III. ADDITIONAL EXEMPTIONS ONLY APPLICABLE TO JUST CAUSE EVICTIONS*:

- 1. Housing accommodations in which the Tenant shares bathroom or kitchen facilities with the Owner who maintains their principal residence at the residential real property.
- Single-family Owner-occupied residences, including a residence in which the Owner-occupant rents or leases no more than two units or bedrooms, including, but not limited to, an accessory dwelling unit.

IV. RENT CAP REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Subject to certain provisions of Civil Code Section 1947.12 subdivision (b), an Owner of real property shall not increase the rental rate for that property more than 5 percent plus the percentage change in the cost of living, or 10 percent, whichever is lower, of the lowest rental amount charged for that property at any time during the 12 months prior to the effective date of the increase.
- 2. If the same Tenant remains in occupancy over any 12-month period, the gross rental rate shall not be increased in more than two increments over that 12-month period.
- 3. For a new tenancy in which no Tenant from the prior tenancy remains, the Owner may establish the initial rate not subject to paragraph 1 of this section. Paragraph 1 of this section is only applicable to subsequent increases after the initial rental rate has been established.

V. JUST CAUSE REASONS FOR TERMINATION OF TENANCY

- 1. "At-Fault" Reasons:
 - A. Default in payment of rent.


